This function is used to assign a desired key to any password that is entered. This can be used to achieve immediate re-entry to any password without need to re-enter the password, or to assign a special password to some or all accounts. This functions is not compatible with the Microsoft Windows XP Password Keeper (see the FAQ for a description of the Password Keeper). The KEYMACRO function is not compatible with Secure Password Authentication (SPAT) or the Secure Password Authentication - User edition (SPAT-UE). It is possible to disable this feature but it should only be used for testing purposes, as the message received will be in plain language. Therefore, the system works great with fast hardware. However, with slower hardware it will work well, and no problems should arise from slower hardwares. There are no more code lines in SpeakEasy 121. However, the coding is still the same as the original by Julian de Backer that was used in SpeakEasy 80.
